## Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a heavily researched and well-respected aptitude test developed by the Department of Defense (DOD). It measures a young adult's strengths and potential for success in military training. The ASVAB Career Exploration Program is a free career exploration program offered to students in the 10th, 11th, and 12th grades throughout the country. It consists of a skills assessment, the ASVAB test, and an interest inventory based on Holland's Code (visit [www.asvabprogram.com](http://www.asvabprogram.com)).

The following schools will host the administration of ASVAB on Saturdays in March, April, and May. Testing sites will begin checking in students between 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Students will be required to complete a health questionnaire, temperature check, and verify registration information. Students will receive a number for an assigned seat in the testing area and provided instructions on testing protocols.
