Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a heavily researched and well-respected aptitude test developed by the Department of Defense (DOD). It measures a young adult's strengths and potential for success in military training. The ASVAB Career Exploration Program is a free career exploration program offered to students in the 10th, 11th, and 12th grades throughout the country. It consists of a skills assessment, the ASVAB test, and an interest inventory based on Holland's Code (visit www.asvabprogram.com).

The following schools will host the administration of ASVAB on Saturdaysin March, April, and May. Testing sites will begin checking in students between 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Students will be required to complete a health questionnaire, temperature check, and verify registration information. Students will receive a number for an assigned seat in the testing area and provided instructions on testing protocols.
